Field Notes of a survey of the line between the East & West Half of Sec' 27 of Township
28 South Range 10 East M.D.M. Survey made Sept 19th 1877 at the request of
J. Q. Buffington G. Bodascei and + + Mabel
In order to establish the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec line between the East and West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the aforesaid Section
I commenced at the corner to Sec's 22, 23, 26 & 27 and ran West at 40 Chains
I found a corner said to have been set by a former County Surveyor, thence West 80
chains and found no Sec' corner, the corner to Sec's 21, 22, 27 & 28 being destroyed
In order to find this corner I ran a line from the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec corner on the line between
Sec's 27 & 28 and intersected the line previously run making the North line of the Sec'
80 chains in length I then set off 40 chains to the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec corner heretofore mentioned.
I then ran South through the center of Sec 27 at 20 $\frac{3}{4}$ Chains found a $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec corner
set by H. C. Ward Sept County Surveyor at 81 $\frac{7}{10}$ chs intersected the South line of the Sec
20 links ^{west} of a $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec corner set by a former County Surveyor. I also found a rock 160 links
west of this point marked as a $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec corner this rock was not in place had no mound
and pits as described in the original field notes, and had evidently rolled or been moved
down the hill from its proper place. I then went to the corner to Sec's 26, 27, 34 & 35
and found this corner as originally set by S. W. Foreman N. S. Dep Surveyor
I then ran West from this corner and at 40 chs and 4 links intersected the line previously
run through the center of the Sec' I then marked this line between the East and West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the
Section from this corner line by setting red wood stakes along the line
