

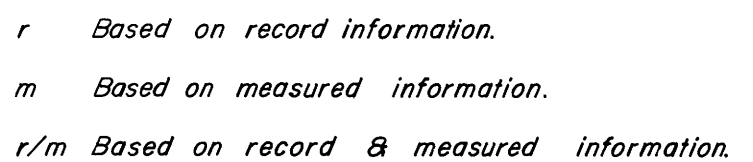
IN THE SW 1/4 OF SEC 9, T1N, R26E, MDB&M,

- ① Found 2" I.D. I.P. & tag RCE 10467. Accepted as 1/16 cor. Sec. 9 per MB 4/24 & PMB 1/97.
- ⊗ Found 4"x4" wood post & tag RCE 7211 per MB 5/122. Post is 0.7' W of 2" pipe. Pipe was set prior to post. Record information indicates that Lee Vining Townsite was established from pipe.
- Found 3/4" I.D. I.P. & tag RCE 10467. Accepted per PMB 1/97.
- ▲ Found T' bar 1' below grade in 3" I.D. galv. pipe. Accepted per MB 4/24.
- Set 1' I.D. I.P. & tag RCE 27104.
- Found 3/4" I.D. I.P. per MB 5/66. Pipe is 2' W of Forest Boundary per MB 4/24. Lot corner reset on Forest Boundary.
- ⊙ Found bent 3/4" I.D. I.P. at edge of curb return. Accepted per MB 5/54.
- Found 15"x15"x6' rock pillar with iron rod. George LaBraque, owner of Lot 5, Block D, MB 1/4, stated that he had constructed pillars and had centered iron rods over 2"x2" hubs, the original lot corner monuments. Accepted as lot corners.



*\*Note: The SW cor. of Parcel 9 was originally set per MB 5/54.  
Field measurements indicate that the cor. was reset per PMB 1/97.*
